FINANCIAL UPDATE

The club remains in good financial shape. At our 12/13 financial snapshot:

- We had \$5,521 available in our checking account, down \$1,629 since last month.
- That is after I transferred \$587 to the Favored End Repair/Replace Fund (ie, 10% of 2023 Membership Dues, the funding process outlined in our club bylaws).
- We had \$12,366 available in the Favored End Repair/Replace Savings Account.
- We received \$1,050 in income from 14 membership renewals for 2024 (we have received at least 3 more since then).
- We paid annual dues for our PO Box (\$210), US Sailing Membership (\$250) and LARC (\$775); those were the last of our 2023 administrative expenses.

Upcoming expenses:

• Our club's annual insurance premium is due in March 2024; the 2023 premium was \$2,334
