The club remains in good financial shape. Financial highlights since March:

- We have \$4,779 in our checking account, up \$788 since last month.
- We gained \$1,071 in membership dues, and \$54 from the March meeting raffle.
- We spent \$322 to create our club racing award ribbons, ordering enough to hold us for the next few seasons. Our next big expense is \$324 due in July to WIX to support our webpage's functionality.

So far, we have \$5,070 in 2023 membership income from 5 new members and 66 member renewals. We are already ahead of our total membership income for 2022, so the updated 2023 budget adds a little extra to fun stuff like awards and the post-race dirt-ups.
