Purser's Update

The club remains in good financial shape. Highlights as of August 8th:

- We have \$6,725 in our checking account, up \$50 since last month.
- As of 8/07, Steak-Out ticketing has netted \$787 from 23 tickets sold minus \$25 in processing fees (also brought in \$59 at the July meeting raffle).
- JHMWSR: reimbursed Fred \$72 to engrave the event's permanent trophies. Will be sending LLSC \$519.20 as their 50/50 share of the event proceeds.
- Spent \$403 on Around Alone permanent trophies and \$384 for our WIX premium business webpage.
- Will be spending \$339 to fully restock our inventory of BFSC logo hats.
